

**Materials I Need:**

**Key for symbols:**

- This symbol represents ideas that can be used for two-year-olds through kindergarten. Please remember to slow way down for two-year-olds and keep the pace moving for five-year-olds.
- ② This symbol represents ideas that can be used for two- and three-year-olds.
- ④ This symbol represents ideas that are best used for four-year-olds through kindergarten.

**Memory Verse:**

**1 Corinthians 16:14: Do everything in love.**

**Hook:**

- Teacher Tip:** Encourage the quiet or hesitant children in your class by asking them to help with special assignments during the morning. They may never volunteer so it is appropriate to call on them to do fun tasks. The first time it may help them to have a leader accompany them to perform the task. Some suggestions include: set up the snack, be a line leader, pass around a missionary offering basket, etc. If the child refuses, offer the job to a different child.
- "Seeing Something That Is True" Center:** Set up a table with several Viewmaster viewers and cards of Winnie the Pooh or some other well-known character. The leader will tell his table he has been looking for Winnie the Pooh. He thought Winnie would be in the classroom this morning. He can point to the wall or look under the table, but he doesn't see Winnie the Pooh or pictures of him. The children will show the Viewmaster to the leader to prove that there are pictures of Winnie the Pooh in the classroom. "In today's Bible Adventure, some of the Corinthians said that Jesus did not come back to life. But many people saw Jesus after He came back to life. They saw Jesus with their own eyes just as you are seeing Winnie the Pooh with your own eyes. They were excited to tell others about Jesus coming back to life just as you are excited to show me the pictures."
- Resurrection Body Will Be Changed:** Bring in five or six whole fruits or vegetables along with their counterpart seeds in individual packages. Have the children match the individual fruit to the appropriate seed. Some suggestions include apples, tangelos, green beans, avocado, nectarine, stalk of grain, seeded grapes, lemons, etc. It would also be fun to have peas in the pod or green beans for the children to break open to find the seeds. As the class progresses, other fruits can be cut open to see where the seed is inside. "In today's Bible Adventure, Paul wrote the Corinthians to tell them that Jesus received a resurrection body. Jesus came back to life, but His body was changed. He had a wonderful new body that was made to live forever and never die. Just as these seeds are lemon seeds, they can change when they are planted to become lemon trees. They will always be lemon seeds, but they will be changed."
- Riding the Clouds:** Bring a large, white pillow to class. Tell the class it is a cloud. When Jesus went up to heaven, His body went up in the air to the clouds. Have a leader (young) carefully place someone on top of the pillow and then pull him around the room for a short ride.
- Hospital Center:** Provide a doctor's kit, blankets and pillows, Band-aids, etc., for a hospital center. Have the children doctor each other or stuffed animals. "In today's Bible Adventure, we will hear great news! Someday our bodies will change into wonderful resurrection bodies like Jesus' body. Resurrection bodies do not get old and die. They will not get sick or hurt. That is good news for those who love Jesus! We won't need doctors and hospitals any more."

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- God Creates All Bodies:** Provide books of birds, fish, animals and people for the children to study. Tell them God made all kinds of bodies. Marvel at how many different kinds of living things God has already created. "In today's Bible Adventure, God gave Jesus a resurrection body just as He had created all other kinds of bodies. Jesus has promised that all those who believe in Him will get a resurrection body, too. A resurrection body is different from the natural bodies we have now. We'll learn in today's Bible Adventure how it is different."
  - A Visiting Bird:** If you have access to a parakeet, cockatiel or parrot, you could bring the bird to class. Show the children the wings. The wings allow the bird to fly. Ask how else God made birds different from how He made us. "In today's Bible Adventure, we'll learn that Jesus had a resurrection body that could go up in the air without wings! Those who love Jesus will also have resurrection bodies. The new resurrection bodies will be different from our bodies now, and they will go up to meet Jesus in the air."
  - Whisper Gospel Game:** Seat children in a circle. Whisper the first part of the memory verse message ("Be on your guard") for the children to whisper to the child next to him until it reaches all the way around. Repeat with the other two segments ("Stand firm in the faith" and "Do everything in love"). If the circle is too big, send the message both directions and see how it comes out in the middle.
  - "Go to Heaven" Action Song:** (*tune: "London Bridge"*)  
I can go to hea-eaven, hea-eaven, hea-eaven.  
I can go to hea-eaven. How can I get there?  
(Catch some children in your arms when they ask "How can I get there?", and say, "Put your faith in Jesus" or "Trust in Jesus.")
  - What Will Heaven Be Like?** Materials needed: Blank page, crayons. In today's Bible Adventure the children will learn about resurrection, Jesus going up into heaven, and how we will some day have a resurrected body. "What do you think heaven will look like?" Using the blank page and crayons, give the children an opportunity to express their thoughts and ideas of what they imagine heaven will look like.
  - Review:** Look over the activities from last week that would best review the lesson for your children and include it as a **Hook** this week.
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## Book:

### Presentation Ideas -

- Color the **1CO10ECGF1**, **1CO10ECGF2**, **1CO10ECGF3**, **1CO10ECGF4** and **1CO10ECGF5** pictures and glue them onto colored construction paper. Show these pictures as you tell the Bible Adventure. Save them for review in future lessons.
- "If I Were A Bird" Finger Play**  
If I were a bird, I'd sing a song, *(Twine thumbs together and move hands like wings.)*  
And fly about the whole day long.  
And when the night comes, go to rest  
Up in my cozy little nest. *(Cup hands together to form nest.)*  
"Today's Bible Adventure tells of Jesus going up, up into the air, but He didn't have wings. Listen to find out what Jesus did have that let Him go up into the clouds."

### Bible Adventure for 2's & 3's-

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF1 picture.)* In Paul's letters he always talked about the gospel--the good news--that Jesus took the punishment that you and I deserve for our sins. Jesus died on the cross, but He did not stay dead. He came back to life. Coming back to life is called "resurrection." That is a big word! We know that Jesus was resurrected because He showed Himself to the disciples many times after He had died on the cross. Jesus' resurrection body was like His old body, but different. The disciples were able to touch His hands where He had nail marks from being on the cross. But Jesus could also go through walls and could appear and disappear.

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF2 picture.)* It was not just the disciples, but also large groups of people who saw Jesus after He was resurrected. Jesus stayed on earth for forty days; then one day on a

mountainside, the disciples watched as Jesus went up, up, up into heaven. With His resurrection body, He could go straight up in the air! It was a wonderful new body that was made to live forever.

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF3 picture.)* Some people in the Corinthian church were saying that there was no resurrection after people died. They needed to be corrected. Paul wrote them that Jesus did come back to life with a resurrection body. All Christians will have the same kind of resurrection body as Jesus had.

Some day Jesus will come back to earth for those who have put their faith in Him. A loud trumpet will sound, and Jesus will appear on the clouds. In a twinkling of an eye (*snap your finger*)--that fast--our bodies will be changed to resurrection bodies. We will go up, up, up to meet Jesus in the air. No airplanes! No wings! We will have a wonderful resurrection body like Jesus!

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF4 picture.)* In heaven our bodies will never get old and die. In heaven we will never get sick or be sad. We will never cry. Jesus will be there and everything will be perfect. While we are still in our natural bodies here on earth, we still want to be selfish sometimes. God wants us to honor Him by loving each other and not being selfish. While we are waiting for Jesus to come back, we are to stand firm in the faith and do everything in love.

**Prayer:** Dear God, thank You for giving us new resurrection bodies to live in heaven. Help us to love others while we are still here on earth. In Jesus' name I pray, amen.

### **Bible Adventure for 4's, 5's & K-**

*(Show the review 1CO07ECGF6 picture.)* In Paul's letters he always talked about the gospel—the good news—that Jesus took the punishment that you and I deserve for our sins. This was the same gospel message that all of the apostles preached. It is faith in Jesus that makes us good enough to live in God's perfect heaven forever.

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF1 picture.)* Part of the good news “gospel” is that Jesus didn't stay dead. He came back to life, and coming back to life is called “resurrection.” Can you say “resurrection” with me? Let's clap the syllables as we say “re-sur-rec-tion.” We know that Jesus was resurrected because He showed Himself to the disciples many times. Several times the disciples were in a room with the doors locked and Jesus suddenly appeared in the room. The disciples touched Him and even ate with Him. Jesus' resurrection body was similar to His old body, but He could also go through walls and appear and disappear.

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF2 picture.)* Paul said, “Jesus showed Himself to other people besides the disciples. Large groups of people saw Jesus at one time. Many of those people are still alive; they will tell you they saw Jesus after His resurrection.” After forty days, the disciples were gathered together on a mountain and watched as Jesus went up, up, up into heaven. With Jesus' resurrection body, He could go straight up in the air. It was a wonderful new body that was made to live forever and never die.

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF3 picture.)* Paul wrote, “Now I have another correction for the Corinthian church. Some people in the church are saying that there is no resurrection after people die. Part of the ‘gospel’ that all the apostles teach is that Jesus came back to life and now has a resurrection body. If Jesus came back to life and has a resurrection body, then you and I will also have the same kind of resurrection body as He had. And now I will tell you the wonderful way in which we will get our new resurrection bodies.

“One of these days Jesus will come back to earth for those who have put their faith in Him. A loud trumpet will sound, and Jesus will appear on the clouds.

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF4 picture.)* “In a twinkling of an eye (*snap your fingers*)—that fast—our bodies will be changed to resurrection bodies, and we will go up, up, up to meet Jesus in the air. No airplanes! No wings! Just a wonderful resurrection body like Jesus' body! Then we will go to live with Jesus forever and ever.

“In heaven our bodies will never get old and die. In heaven we will never get sick or be sad; we will never cry. There will be no darkness, and our bodies won't ever get tired.” I'm looking forward to heaven because Jesus will be there and everything will be perfect. God makes sure that everything in heaven is perfect forever.

*(Show the 1CO10ECGF5 picture.)* Paul said, “Heaven is perfect, but we are not in heaven yet. We are still in our natural bodies here on earth, and we still feel tempted to be selfish. God wants us to honor Him by loving each other. He wants us to be on guard against arguing and fighting. Don't be lazy and selfish. Stand firm in the faith that I have taught you. Do everything in love.”

**Prayer:** Dear God, thank You for giving us new resurrection bodies to live in heaven. Help us to love others while we are still here on earth. In Jesus' name I pray, amen.

## Aim Questions

### Aim Questions for 2's & 3's:

1. Who received a new resurrection body after He died on the cross? (*Jesus.*)
2. Who will come back in the clouds to get those who have faith in Him? (*Jesus.*)
3. Who else will receive resurrection bodies when Jesus comes back? (*All Christians.*)
4. What are we to do while we wait for Jesus to return? (*Love each other and not be selfish.*)

### Aim Questions for 4's & 5's:

1. Who received a resurrection body after He died on the cross? (*Jesus.*)
2. What does resurrection mean? (*Coming back to life.*)
3. Who will receive resurrection bodies when Jesus comes back? (*All Christians. When Jesus comes back for us, He gives us resurrection bodies that live forever.*)
4. What does Paul tell us to do while we are still in our natural bodies? (*Love each other and not be selfish. Say the memory verse.*)



### Look:

- Aim Questions:** Bring a toy horn or kazoo to class. Choose a child who can count to blow one, two, or three times for the question that will be asked. The questions should be numbered and posted in plain sight. Choose a different child from the story circle to go get the number that coincides with the horn blasts.
- Transition Idea:** Put your fist up to your mouth to represent a horn. Encourage the children to make a trumpet sound as they move from one area to another.
- Snack:** "Let's pretend we are in heaven with Jesus. Jesus will be everywhere and we will love to be with Him. Everything we want to eat will taste good. Even things you don't like now will taste good in heaven! What would be your choice for breakfast, lunch or dinner?" Provide a snack you know to be one of the children's favorites.
- Activity Page Comes to Life: (1CO10ECGF6 and 1CO10ECGF7)** Materials needed for each child: One GF6 page with a 2" slit cut at the center bottom of the clouds, one GF7 1" x 8" paper strip of Jesus copied on cardstock paper, cotton balls for clouds, glue stick, and crayons. Let the children color the disciples who are looking up, glue cotton balls onto the clouds, and slide the GF7 Jesus strip up through the clouds. While the children are working, talk about how Jesus went up into heaven as the disciples watched. "Isn't that amazing? Can we go up in the air? When will we go up in the air like Jesus?" (*When the trumpet sounds and Jesus comes back on the clouds.*) Sing "I Can Go to Heaven" (see **Hook** section) as the children slide Jesus up in the air.
- Jesus Resurrected: (1CO10ECGF7 and 1CO10ECGF8)** Materials needed: Large styrofoam cups, GF7 strip of Jesus copied on cardstock paper, GF8 picture of the disciples, crayons, large tongue depressor (optional). Let the children color their GF7 Jesus and GF8 disciples. Make a slit in the bottom of the styrofoam cup to slide the GF7 strip through. Turn the cup upside down and glue the disciples on the cup so that they are looking upward toward the narrow end with the slit. The children can glue cotton balls around the narrow end of the cup to make it look like there are clouds. They can move the Jesus figure up and down through the slot.
- Heaven-Bound Suitcase: (1CO10ECGF10)** Fold a colored piece of construction paper in half. Tape two, six-inch pieces of yarn to the edges opposite the fold to form handles. Let children decorate the outsides of their suitcases and glue a GF10 picture page (What Will I Take to Heaven?) on the inside. The children can color the pictures and then cross out the things that will be left behind when Jesus returns. Talk about what will not be found in heaven--no tears, no sickness, no anger, no darkness. Talk about how Jesus will be with us and that is the best thing.
- How Fast Can You Change?** "When Jesus comes back to earth, He will give all Christians resurrection bodies. It will be a quick change. (Snap your fingers.) We are used to changing our clothes. How fast can you get dressed?" Choose two or three children to put on the same clothes at the same time and see who is the fastest. Clothes that can be included are: hat, shirt, vest, pants (large) and shoes. Start the children with these words: "Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; do everything in love. Go!"

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- The Animal Walk Game:** God made all kinds of animals. Let's try to move like some of the animals we know.  
Crab walk: back to floor, walking on hands and feet  
Puppy dog: walk on hands and feet with stomach toward floor  
Elephant walk: stand with one arm at side and other hanging next to head (trunk) and walk swaying from side to side  
Rabbit jump: move both hands forward on the floor, jump both feet up to them  
Seal walk: walk on hands with arms fully extended and drag body  
Bear walk: lift right hand and right foot forward, lift left hand and foot forward  
Alligator walk: use elbows to pull self along the floor while on stomach  
Donkey kick: put weight on hands and kick feet out behind
- Heaven and Earth Action Review:** Show the children a picture of a home and also one of clouds. Review what it is like to live on earth at home (we are sometimes hungry, crabby, tired, sick, old, feeling pain, lazy, selfish, dying) and what it is like to live at home in heaven with Jesus (no crying, no pain, no sickness, no sadness, no darkness, never tired, never die). Let the children tell you what they remember. When you hold up the picture of home and say, "At home we get hungry," the children act out hunger by rubbing their tummies until you put up the picture of heaven when they happily walk around looking up. (Anyone who doesn't quit the action when you give the signal should sit down.) Do the same with other actions (rub eyes as though crying, bend over and hold stomach as though sick, drag yourself up as though lazy, be "grabby" as though selfish, etc.).
- Memory Verse Review:** Talk to the children about the fact that doing things in love means doing them kindly, obediently, happily, not fighting and arguing, but thinking of others before yourself. "God wants us to do everything in love until we go to heaven to be with Jesus." Seat the children in a circle on chairs and sing the following words to the tune of "Mulberry Bush" with appropriate motions.  
This is the way we brush our teeth, brush our teeth, brush our teeth.  
This is the way we brush our teeth. Do everything in love.  
Other actions to include might be: pick up toys, mix cookies to share, eat our food, share with friends, care for brother, read the Bible, make our bed, set the table, wash the car, give a hug.
- Guess What I Am Lovingly Doing Until Jesus Returns:** Let a child come up and pull out of a bag a paper that has an action written on it. See the list in the **Memory Verse Review** above. Whisper to the child what it says and let him act it out for the others to guess.
- Looking to Heaven Bible Adventure Review:** Have the children lay on their backs on the floor with their heads together and legs straight out so that together they look like a flower. Ask them to close their eyes and pretend to be looking into heaven. "What did we learn today about heaven? Who gets to go there? Who gets resurrection bodies? Who will be there with us all the time? How do we act until we get to go there?" When you touch a child on their foot, they get to answer.
- "Get the Wiggles Out" Action Chant:** Have the children stand around the room with a partner and do the following motions after you tell them where to place their hands:  
Hands on your ears (move head from side to side)  
Hands on your nose (move head up and down)  
Hands on your shoulders (circle shoulders)  
Hands on your toes (lift toes of one foot and then other)  
  
Hands on your tummy (turn side-to-side and rub in circles)  
Hands on your legs (lift one at a time stiff-legged)  
Hands on your partner's hands (clap hands with partner)  
Hands carry heavy bags (hands down, lean from side to side)  
God's Word says, "Do everything in love." (Hug partner and smile)
- Jesus Returns Game:** Create a hiding place in the room behind where the children will be seated. Ask the children to sit on the floor with their eyes covered. Choose one child to secretly go hide, blow a horn and say, "Jesus returns." The other children take turns guessing who said that. When the correct one is named, the child returns to the floor and all the children say, "Resurrection!" Select another child after they cover their eyes and repeat.

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- Resurrection Tag:** “Jesus gives us a new resurrection body like His own. That will be a wonderful thing to celebrate.” Choose a child to be “It.” This child calls out an action (hopping, skipping, tiptoeing, walking in giant steps, walking with hands on hips, sliding feet, etc.). When a child is tagged, “It” gives him a new action to do because he has been changed!!! Continue until everyone has been changed.

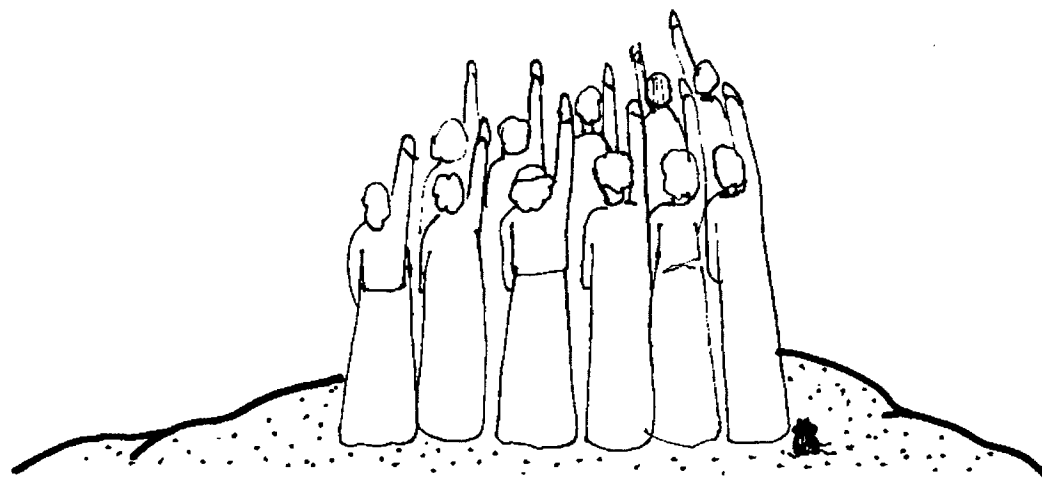
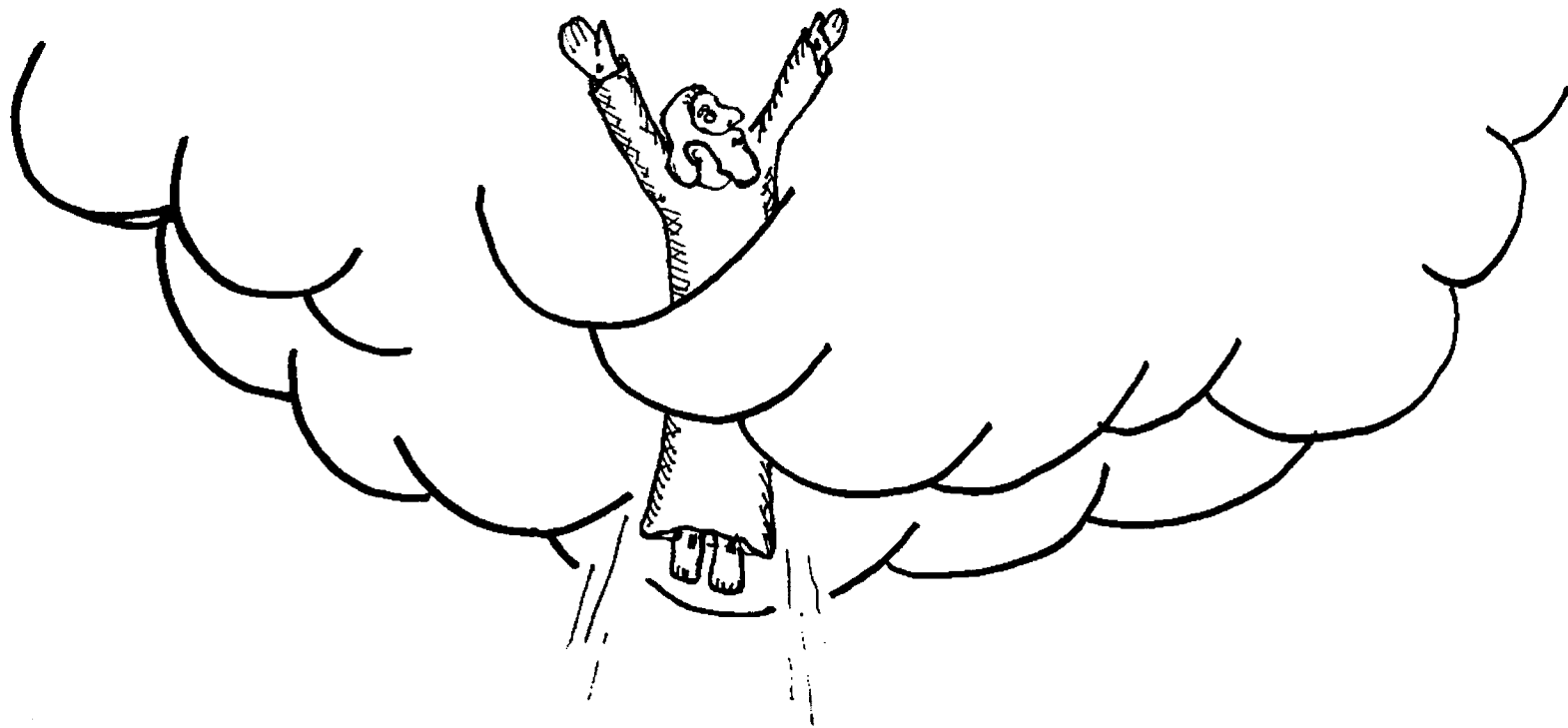
- Trumpet Necklace: (1CO10ECGF9)** Either use toilet paper tubes or paper cups with the ends cut out of them. Children can decorate their “trumpets” with a memory verse sticker, other stickers, and marking pens. Punch two holes near one end of the trumpet and tie yarn through them to hang around the children’s necks. “This is a reminder that someday we will hear a trumpet; Jesus will come back in the clouds; and people who believe in Him will get new resurrection bodies and join Him in the air!” Review with the children what this trumpet represents. What will we do until He comes back? Review the Memory Verse. Sing “He’ll Be Comin’ Down from Heaven” and toot your trumpet twice at the end of each line (see **Songs** section).

- “How Should We Act?” Game:** This will be a follow-the-leader game acting out examples of how we should and should not act. Seat the children in a circle. The teacher will review the Bible Adventure from today and then bring in the actions. When the teacher says, “Jesus wants us to be on guard,” the children should follow the teacher’s example and stand up looking around with their hand at their forehead as if to shade the light. Another example would be when you say, “Don’t get lazy,” all the children could lie down as if lazy and tired. Others might be: Honor God, don’t fight, don’t argue, stand firm in the faith, do everything in love.

 **Preschool Page for Parents: (1CO10ECPPP)** Send a page home with each child, encouraging parents to reinforce the Bible truths at home. Spend a few minutes before the children go home creatively reviewing the song and memory verse.
