Lesson 13

Jesus is Alive!

(John 19:16b-20:31)

Note: If using flannel board, set up the scene with Jesus on the cross and women around the cross.

STORY:

See the ladies.
They are crying.
They are sad.

Show women (picture 13a).
Make a sad face.

They are sad because Jesus is hurt.
Jesus has owies on His hands.
Jesus has owies on His feet.
Jesus has a big owie in His heart.
Jesus is on a cross.

Show Jesus on the cross (picture 13b).
Point to Jesus' hands and feet.

Point to the cross.

Jesus is strong!
Jesus can get down!

Make a strong gesture.

But Jesus said,
"I will let them hurt me.
I will not stop them.
I will not get down."

Shake head "no."

So Jesus stayed on the cross.
The ladies are sad.
Now Jesus won't talk.
Jesus won't move.
Jesus is dead.
The ladies are very sad.

Point to Jesus on the cross (picture 13a or 13b).
Point to the ladies and make a sad face (picture 13a).
Shake head "no."
Make a sad face.

Jesus is gone.
His friends can't see Him.
His friends can't walk with Him.
Goodbye, Jesus.
We miss you, Jesus.

Show Jesus' tomb (picture 13c).
Shake head "no."

Wave to Jesus on the cross (picture 13b).
Take away the cross.

But Jesus' friends did not stay sad.
Jesus came back!
They saw Jesus!
They talked to Jesus!
They walked with Jesus!
Jesus is back!
Jesus is alive again!
Now the friends are happy!
I am happy, too!

Shake head "no."
Show Jesus (picture 13d).
Show excitement in your voice.

Smile and clap.

Point to friends.
Smile and clap.

REVIEW:

Did Jesus stop the people? [no]
Jesus let the people hurt Him.
Then Jesus went away.
Did Jesus come back? [yes]
Jesus is alive!

SING:

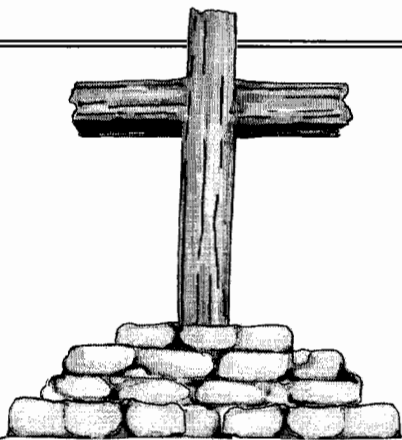
(Review songs from past lessons.)

PRAY:

Thank Jesus for staying on the cross.
Thank Jesus for coming back.

MEMORY VERSE:

Work on the scripture memory verses and/or *Foundation Verses*.

Lesson 13 **Jesus is Alive!**

STORY:

Jesus Died and is Alive Again (John 19:16b-20:31)

THEME:

Jesus is Alive!

AT HOME:

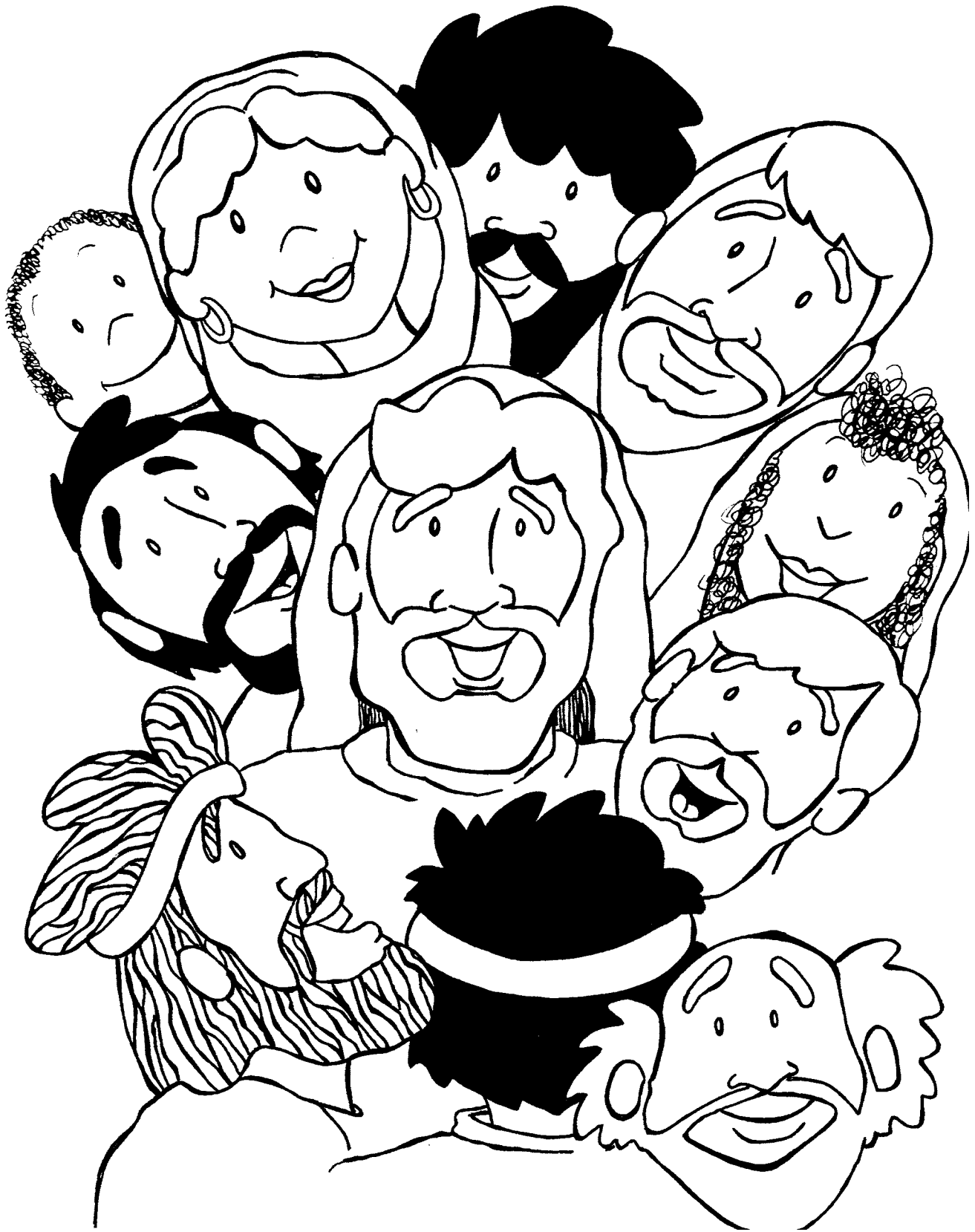
Show pictures of Jesus on the cross. Talk about Him, being sad because Jesus is on the cross. Tell your child that Jesus had many owies and then Jesus didn't move or talk. Then tell your child that Jesus came back! Jesus could move and talk. Jesus is alive.

Throughout the day, point out to your child things that are alive and things that are not alive. (You may want to stay with the simplest meaning possible. For example, "The dog can walk. The dog can lick my face. The dog is alive. The table can't walk. The table is not alive.")

PRAY:

Thank Jesus for coming back. Praise Jesus that He is alive.
