Show picture 2d.

Make this statement very loud and boastfully.

**PRAY:**

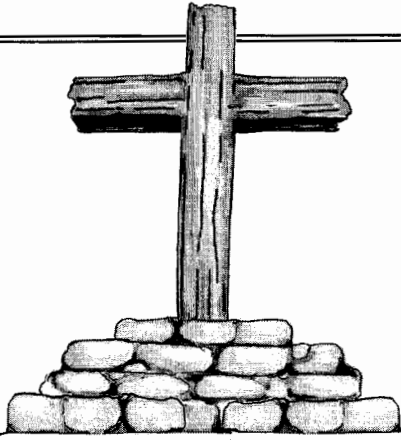
Confess that it is wrong to disobey God and to want to be like God.

When you tell your child "no" and your child disobeys, make sure your child understands that this is wrong.

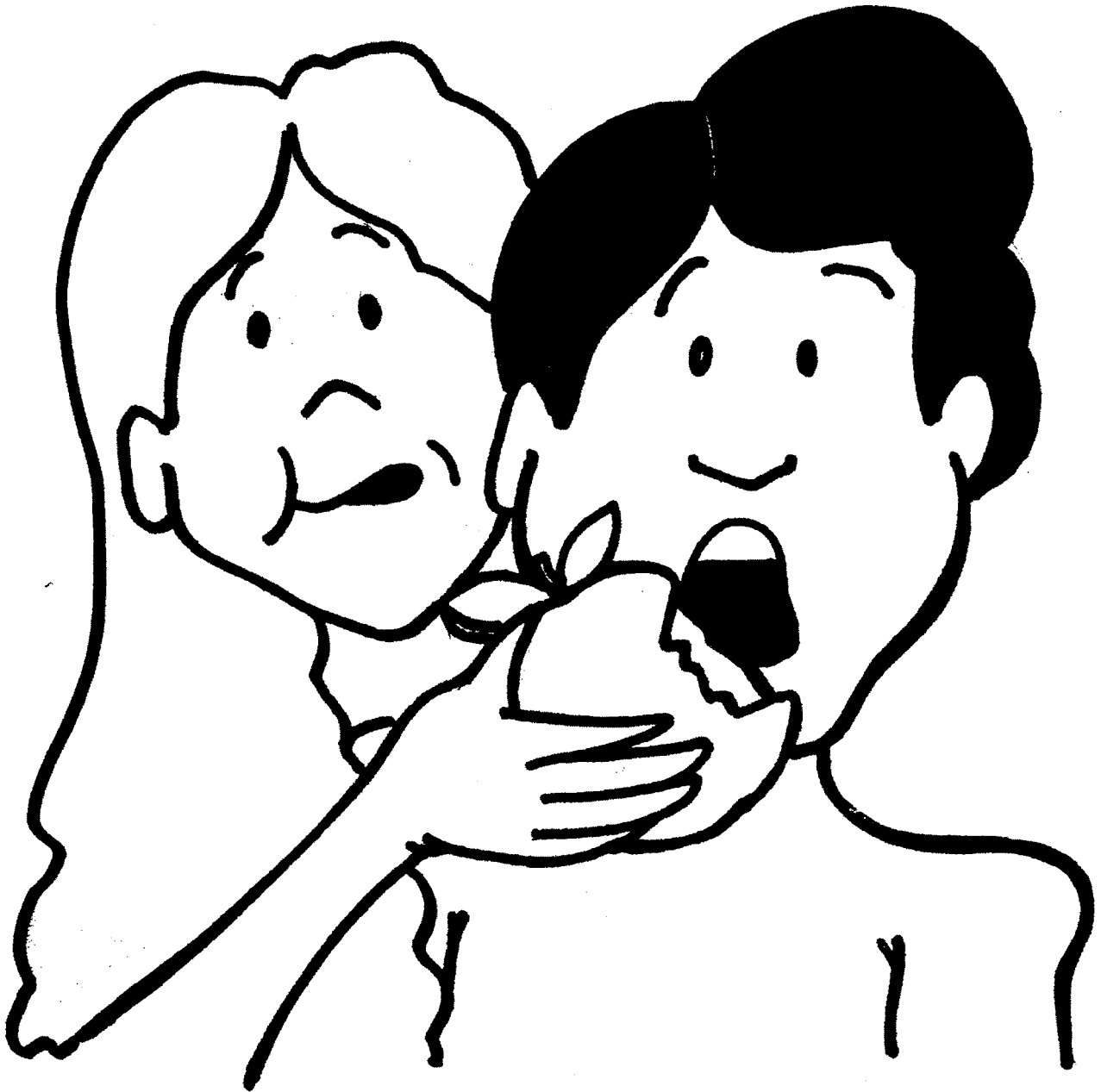
Ask your child, "Can you make a tree?" Then say, "No. Only God can make a tree."
