Lesson 3 **God is Good** (Genesis 21:1-7)

STORY:

God loved Abraham.
God said, "I will give you a baby."

Abraham waited and waited.
No baby!
Abraham waited and waited.
No baby!
Abraham waited and waited.
Nooooooooo baby.

Abraham is old.
Sarah is old.
But they have no baby.

God knows about Abraham.
God knows about Sarah.
God knows about the baby.

Then one day...
God gave Abraham a baby.
Yeah, God!
God is good.
God does everything He says!
Yeah, God!
God told Abraham,
"I will give you a baby."
And God gave Abraham a baby.

Show Abraham (picture 3a).
Nod your head "yes."

Show a sad face and shake your head "no."

Rest your head on your hand; yawn.
Show a sad face and shake your head "no."

Show old Abraham and Sarah (picture 3b).
Shake your head "no," and show a sad face.

Point up. Point to Abraham and then to Sarah.

Show Abraham and baby (picture 3c).
Clap.

Clap and encourage the children to clap.

Smile and point to the baby.

REVIEW:

Abraham did not have a baby.
Who said, "I will give you a baby"? [God]
Abraham got very old. He did not have a baby.
Will God give Abraham a baby? [yes]
God is good!

SING:**God Is So Good**

God is so good, God is so good.
God is so good, He's so good to me.
God loves me so, God loves me so.
God loves me so, He loves me so.
God answers prayers, God answers prayers.
God answers prayers, He answers prayers.

Praise Him, Praise Him (Use the words "God is good")

Praise Him, praise Him, all ye little children.
God is good, God is good.
Praise Him, praise Him, all ye little children.
God is good, God is good.

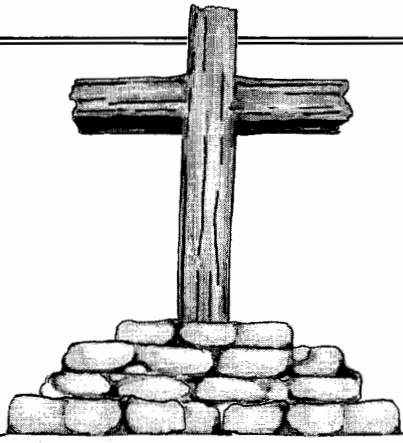
(Review songs you learned in Lessons 1 and 2.)
