Lesson 5

God Knows Everything

(1 Kings 17:1-6)

STORY:

This is Ahab.
He does not love God.
He does not like Elijah.

Run, Elijah, run.
Run away from Ahab.

Where will Elijah go?
God knows.
God knows everything.
"Go outside."
Live near the rocks," God said.
"I will take care of you."

What will Elijah drink?
What will Elijah eat?
God knows.
God knows everything.

"Drink from the brook, Elijah.
It is full of water," said God.
"I will send birds to feed you."

Elijah went to the rocks.
Elijah drank the water.
The birds brought Elijah bread.
The birds brought Elijah meat.

Just like God said.
God knows everything.
God took care of Elijah.
God is good.

Show Ahab (picture 5a, the angry man).
Shake head "no."
Show Elijah (the other man in 5a) and shake head "no."

Move your arms like are you running.

Put your palms up in a questioning gesture.
Point up and shake head "yes."

Show rocks (picture 5b).

Show brook (picture 5b).
(Note: This will be an unfamiliar word to toddlers, but by seeing the brook they can learn a new word. You could mention that it is like a stream of water.)

Pretend to drink from your cupped hands while making a slurping sound.
Show birds (picture 5c).

Make an expansive gesture with your arms to show "everything."

REVIEW:

What did Elijah drink? [water]
What did Elijah eat? [bread & meat]
Who gave Elijah water? [God]
Who sent the birds to Elijah? [God]
God knows everything.
God took care of Elijah.
God is good.

SING:**God Is So Good**

God is so good, God is so good.
God is so good, He's so good to me.
God loves me so, God love me so.
God loves me so, He loves me so.
God answers prayer, God answers prayer.
God answers prayer, He answers prayer.

Praise Him, Praise Him (Use the words "God is good.")

Praise Him, praise Him, all ye little children.
God is good, God is good.
Praise Him, praise Him, all yet little children.
God is good, God is good.

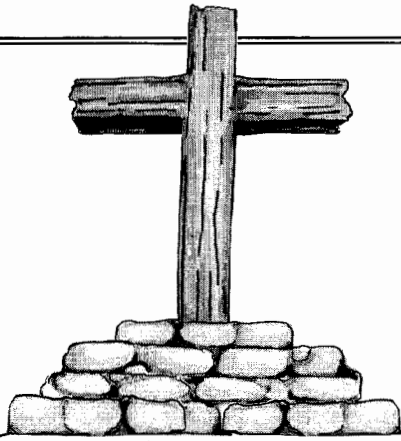
(Review songs from past lessons.)

STORY:

God Feeds Elijah (1 Kings 17:1-6)

THEME:

God Knows Everything

AT HOME:

Make statements comparing your knowledge to God's knowledge. For example, "I don't know how to make rain. God knows! God knows everything!"

Ask your child questions about things he does not know. Then tell him that God knows everything. For example, "Do you know that man's name? God knows. God knows everything."

Talk about Elijah. Remind your child that Elijah didn't know how to find water. Elijah didn't know how to find food. God knew how to provide food and water.

PRAY:

Praise God that He knows everything.
